## ORDER

As per the letter read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, the Chairman, CBSE has informed that admission to National Institutes of Technology (NITs), Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) like IITs etc, the merit / rank list shall be prepared based on 40% weightage to Board marks and 60% weightage to JEE (Main). He has further informed that the number of attempts which a candidate can avail at JEE (Main) can be limited to three uniformly for all the candidates in consecutive years and the candidates passed Plus Two examination in 2011 or 2012 or appearing Plus Two Examination in 2013 are only eligible to appear in JEE (Main), 2013 with a further order that candidates passed Plus Two in 2010 or before or appearing in 2014 are not eligible to appear JEE (Main), 2013. The Chairman, CBSE has, therefore, requested the Director, Higher Secondary Education to permit the students who have appeared in Class XII Board Examination, 2011 to appear in all subjects for the Board Examination in 2013 as 'onetime exception', to improve their performance if they wish.

(2) Based on the above request of the Chairman, CBSE, the Director, Higher Secondary Education as per his letter read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above has forwarded a detailed proposal to Government. The Director, Higher Secondary Education has stated that if the proposal of the Chairman, CBSE is approved by the Government, the following points are also to be considered for orders

- (i) Candidates have to appear for all the six subjects in the improvement examination.
- (ii) In the system followed by the Board, Higher Secondary results are finalized by considering the I&II year scores.
- (iii) If improvement examination is conducted for I&II year papers, a candidate has to appear for total 12 papers (6+6).
- (iv) If the candidates are allowed to improve I&II year papers then they have to appear for the II year papers, along with the candidates of HSE, March 2013 and I year papers as a separate examination.
- (v) The scores obtained in this examination will be valid only for the purpose of JEE. The Higher Secondary Examination results of these candidates published in 2012 will not be modified considering these scores.

(3) Government have examined the matter in detail. The proposal forwarded by the Director, Higher Secondary Education as per the letter read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above deserves detailed examinations. However *in principle sanction* is accorded for conducting Plus One & Plus Two examinations of the academic years 2010-2011, 2011-2012 and 2012 and 2013 for improving the performance of the students who have appeared /appearing examinations for these years of Kerala Higher Secondary Education as is being done in the case of CBSE as a 'one time exception'. The other points raised by the Director, Higher Secondary Education will be examined and resolved in the meanwhile separately.
